General Information and Admission Procedures

(1) M.C. College conducts B.A., B.Sc. and BCA programmes following Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) under Gauhati University. An undergraduate programme (BA/BSc/BCA) consists of six semesters covering three calendar years. Each student must take admission in three consecutive Academic Sessions starting with the first semester. Students who do not enroll in the Second Academic Session will not be eligible to take admission in the Third Academic Session.

- (a) BSc with Honours
- (b) BA with Honours
- (c) BSc Regular (without Honours)
- (d) BA Regular (without Honours)
- (e) Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA)

(3) Availability of seats

BSc (Honours + Regular) = 300

BA (Honours + Regular) = 500

BCA = 30

(5) Instructions for online form fill-up and admission procedure

- (i) M.C. College conducts admission in online mode. For applying online, the candidate must visit <http://www.mccollegeonline.co.in>. In the website, first the candidate must register by selecting 'New Registration' tab.
- (ii) While creating the User Id, the candidate should use a functional 10-digit mobile number.
[This registered mobile number should be kept activated till he/she passes out from college.]
- (iii) Every applicant must have a working email id of his/ her own, as OTP will be sent to this email id for confirmation of registration.
- (iv) After registration, the candidate will be able to download the prospectus. It is advisable to go through the prospectus before choosing any subject combination. Only after going through the prospectus, one should fill up the online form.
- (v) Before filling up the online application form, the candidate must scan the following documents/items. The scanned copies must be uploaded in jpg or jpeg format when prompted by the online system.
 - a) Recent passport size photograph of the candidate
 - b) Candidate's full signature
 - c) Marksheet of H.S. final or equivalent examination.
 - d) Certificate from the Head of the Institution from where he/she passed H.S. final or equivalent examination.
 - e) Certificate for SC/ST/OBC/MOBC/DA (Differently Abled) (for students seeking admission under reserved category)
 - f) Proficiency Certificate (If the candidate applies for EC/NCC/Scouts & Guide/NSS quota)
 - g) Income and Asset Certificate issued by competent authority for EWS quota.
 - h) Applicant's Bank Passbook
 - i) Domicile State Certificate (PRC/Voter ID/ADHAR card/BPL Card of family/Birth Certificate issued by Registrar of Birth and Death/pass port of Self or parent.)
- (vi) The candidate will have to produce the hard copy of the form generated after filling up the online form at the time of admission.
- (vii) Mark Sheets, certificates and all other relevant documents will be verified by the admission committee at the time of admission.
- (viii) The applicant must generate 'Unique Id' by visiting the website of Directorate of Higher Education, Govt. of Assam using the following link: <http://dheonlineadmission.amtron.in/sp/>
The selected candidates must submit the Unique Id at the time of admission, otherwise his/her admission will be treated as incomplete.
- (ix) The applicant must also bring an unattested copy of his/her recent stamp size colour photograph.
- (x) The Merit list will be published on the dates mentioned elsewhere.
- (xi) Applications are processed and finalized by the Admission Committee.

- (xii) If any candidate passed the H.S. or equivalent examination before the current year (2022), he/she must upload a 'Gap Certificate' from a competent person at the time of admission.
- (xiii) In case of any dispute about any matter concerning admission, the decision of the principal will be final.

(6) Subjects/courses for study

A student willing to admit in a BA/BSc/BCA programme will have to study different types of courses/papers over the six semesters as per Gauhati University regulations. Details of course requirements are given below programmewise:

BSc with Honours

1. *Honours Subject*: A student willing to admit in BSc Honours programme can choose any one of the six Science subjects: Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Zoology, Botany, Anthropology and Geography subject to the fulfilment of requisite marks and combinations in the H.S. or equivalent examination. A student of BSc Honours programme will have to study 14 core courses (HC) and 4 Elective Courses (HE) under the subject chosen over six semesters.

2. *Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC)*: English Communication in the first semester and Environmental studies in the second semester.

3. *Generic Elective (GE) Courses*: A student has to study one GE course (HG) per semester up to fourth semester. All the science and Arts departments offer GE courses. Students are advised to choose GE papers after going through the syllabus.

4. *Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)*: A student has to study two SEC courses - one in the third semester and another one in the fourth semester. All the science and Arts departments offer SEC. Students are advised to choose SEC after going through the syllabus.

BSc Regular (without Honours)

1. *Regular Subjects*: Students willing to admit in BSc Regular programme has to choose any one of the following combinations of disciplines as regular subjects (subject to the fulfilment of requisite marks and combinations in the H.S. or equivalent examination):

Chemistry, Botany, Zoology
Physics, Mathematics, Computer Science
Economics, Mathematics, Computer Science
Physics, Mathematics, Geography
Botany, Zoology, Geography

A student of BSc regular programme will have to study 4 Core Courses (RC) and 2 Elective Courses (RE) each under the three subjects chosen over six semesters.

2. *Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC)*: English Communication in the first semester and Environmental studies in the second semester.

3. *Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)*: A student has to study one SEC course per semester starting from third semester up to sixth semester. All the science and Arts departments offer SEC. Students are advised to choose SEC after going through the syllabus.

(7) In order to study courses/papers of subject(s) in the left-hand column of the table given below, a student must have secured pass marks in the corresponding subject(s) (mentioned in the right-hand column) in the Higher Secondary Examination:

BA with Honours

1. *Honours Subject*: A student willing to admit in BA Honours programme can choose any one of the ten subjects: English, Assamese, Economics, Political Science, Education, Anthropology, Mathematics, History, Geography, and Philosophy subject to the fulfilment of requisite marks in the H.S. or equivalent examination. A student of BA Honours programme will have to study 14 core courses (HC) and 4 Elective Courses (HE) under the subject chosen over six semesters.

2. *Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC)*: English Communication or Assamese Communication in the first semester and Environmental studies in the second semester.

3. *Generic Elective (GE) Course*: A student has to study one GE course (HG) per semester up to fourth semester. All the science and Arts departments offer GE courses. Students are advised to choose GE papers after going through the syllabus.

4. *Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)*: A student has to study two SEC courses- one in the third semester and another in the fourth semester. All the science and Arts departments offer SEC. Students are advised to choose SEC after going through the syllabus.

BA Regular (without Honours)

1. *Compulsory Courses*

- (a) English in the first semester and second semester
- (b) MIL Assamese or Alternative English in the third and fourth semester
- (c) Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC): English Communication or Assamese Communication in the first semester and Environmental studies in the second semester.

2. *Regular Subjects*: Students willing to admit in BA Regular programme has to choose any one of the following combinations of subjects:

A student of BA regular programme will have to study 4 Core Courses and 2 Elective Courses each in two subjects chosen over six semesters.

3. *Generic Elective (GE) Course*: A student has to study one GE course per semester in the fifth and sixth semester. He or she has to choose GE courses from any subject(s) other than the two regular core subjects chosen. All the Arts and Science departments offer Generic Elective (GE) courses. Students are advised to choose GE papers after going through the syllabus.

4. *Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC)*: A student has to study one SEC course per semester starting from third semester up to sixth semester. All the science and Arts departments offer SEC. Students are advised to choose SEC after going through the syllabus.

(10) Procedure for selection of honours subject

Selection of honours subject will be done on the day of admission on the basis of general merit list on first come first serve basis.

(11) Procedure for selection of Generic Elective and Regular subjects

Students will be allotted Generic Elective courses for the BA/BSc Honours programme and Regular subjects for the BA/BSc regular programme strictly on the basis of order of merit.

(12) Admission to BCA programme

- Eligibility: The candidate must have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent level examination from Science/Commerce/Arts Stream. Students who have passed the Higher Secondary examination with either Mathematics or Computer Science as one of the subjects obtaining minimum pass mark in the subject will be given preference at the time of admission. Students completing Diploma in CSE/IT from AICTE recognized institutes are also eligible for taking admission.
- The College may set cut-off marks whenever it seems to be reasonable or may hold admission test for the final selection of candidates.
- Students who are not from HS Science stream will have to take up a bridge course in addition to the normal courses in the 1st semester.
- Fees: Rs. 10, 000 per semester

(13) Waiver of admission fee, tuition fee, etc. by Govt of Assam

M. C. College will follow the fee-waiver scheme if the Government of Assam notifies such a scheme for the academic session 2022-23. The students applying for the benefit under the scheme will have to produce all the related documents at the time of admission as prescribed by the Government of Assam.

(14) Reservation of Seats

A. Caste Reservation Quota

There is provision for reservation of seats for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes /Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward classes. The quotas of reservation are as follows: OBC/MOBC-15%, SC-7%, ST(P)-10%, and ST(H)-5%. In this respect, the candidate will have to produce caste certificate issued by a competent authority under the Govt. of Assam.

B. Extra-Curricular Activity Quota

Provision is also there for reservation of a very limited number of seats for the candidates having shown excellence in sports and culture (at state level in the minimum) as well as the NCC 'A' and 'B' certificate holders and Rajya Puraskar and Rastrapati Puraskar Certificate holders of Scout & Guide. Candidates seeking such reservation should select the appropriate button in the Online Application Form. They must also upload the necessary certificates of their proficiency while filling up the form. A maximum 5% of the seats are earmarked as per break up given below for Outstanding Sports Persons / NCC Cadets / proficiency in cultural activities/wards of the employees of the colleges, etc.

- (a) 2% for Sports Persons of sports recognized by IOA/ SAI and also have represented District, State, or The Country or played in the National Level.
- (b) 1 % for wards of employees of the college
- (c) 1 % for NCC/Scouts & Guides/ NSS
- (d) 1 % for the students with achievements in cultural activities.

C. *Economically Weaker Section (EWS) quota:*

As per the rules of Government of Assam, there is a provision of 10% reservation for Economically Weaker Section in the unreserved category. A candidate is eligible to apply for seats reserved under this quota if the gross annual income of his/ her 'family' is below Rs. 6 lakh (Rupees Six Lakh only) for the current financial year. His/ her family must not own or possess any of the following assets:

- (i) 15 Bigha of agricultural Land and above in rural area.
- (ii) 1 Bigha of residential land and above in rural area.
- (iii) 1.5 Katha of land in notified Municipal Corporation/ Municipal Board/ Town Committee Area.
- (iv) House of built-up area more than 1000 Sq. ft. and above in notified Municipal Corporation/Municipal Board/ Town Committee area.

A candidate who wants to apply for seats reserved under this quota must upload an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Local Circle Officer or Circle Officer(A) of revenue circle in the prescribed format of Govt. of Assam.


D. *DA quota:* There is a provision of 3% reservation for 'Differently Abled' (or Person with disability) candidates as per rules of govt. of Assam.

Reserved seats under all categories will be settled on the basis of merit of candidates concerned in each category.

(15) Fees For Undergraduate (BA/BSc) Programmes

Cash is not accepted for any type of payment at M C College. Admission Fees must be paid through ATM card at the time of admission.
